Statement of Understanding for Parents / Care Givers – HICES G & T Camp 2022

Please read carefully. This document must be returned to the school **signed** with the Consent Form.

- We cannot guarantee the refund of any or all of the payment for the camp for non -attendance until all accounts related to the camp have been paid in full.
- AGH Camp staff will run through safety and evacuation procedures with HICES and staff and students upon arrival at the camp.
- Children may be undertaking a range of activities, including: craft, drama, videoing skits etc.
- Students will be accommodated in cabins within ensuites, or, with amenities within close proximity (25m, undercover walkway, well lit) to rooms. Cabins will sleep between 4 – 8 students per room, most with bunk beds. Your child may be allocated a top bunk. Boys will be accommodated separately from girls.
- Teachers will be accommodated in close proximity to students and students will be made aware of these locations in case of emergency during the night.
- Students will be given clear instructions as to the expectation that they should not be out of their cabins after lights out, except in case of an emergency. They will be told at time that they may leave the cabins in the morning.
- Teachers will do regular patrols of cabins after lights out until they feel that all students are asleep.
- Where students' behaviour places themselves or others at risk, parents may be contacted and asked to come and collect their child from the camp.
- Students must wear covered shoes at all times. No thongs or sandals (except for the shower)
- The camp takes place in a bushland setting and ticks are common. Parents should keep an eye on this upon students' return from camp. If your child has any particular allergy to ticks please inform staff.
- Contact with your child during camp is not recommended as this can upset other children who may be missing their parents. We will contact you immediately if necessary.
- We request that no mobile phones are taken to camp.
- Transport to and from the camp is the responsibility of parents and caregivers.
- It is the parents' responsibility to provide full medical information about their child as well as to provide any specific medication required. Teachers must be notified that a child has the medication and be given clear directions as to how and when it is to be administered. Please give to the First Aid Officer on arrival.
- A full risk assessment of this camp has been undertaken by staff to identify potential risks and students with known medical conditions and have put in place strategies to manage these.
- This information will be communicated to all staff prior to the camp and the risk management document will be present at the camp.
- There is a sign out book at camp. Should it be necessary for you to remove your child from camp for any reason, you must sign this book before you leave.
- Students each have a Code of Conduct to sign.
